On the Way to Leavenworth

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see "Driving Directions" below.

From Vancouver, BC

Drive south on I-5...

This thoroughly scenic drive is full of natural beauty. Shortly after you cross the border, you will drive through **Bellingham**, the "hub of northwest Washington." Here you will find a massive shopping area, **Bellis Fair Mall**, with more than 150 specialty stores and six department stores. If you're not up for shopping, the mall's food court should be more to your tastes. Farther south is **Burlington Factory Outlet Mall** with more than 50 direct-to-buyer-from-manufacturer shops. If you happen to be there in June, keep an eye out for the **Berry and Dairy Days** celebrations.

Continue south on I-5 to Everett...

Stroll the boardwalk that runs along the second largest marina on the West Coast. Washington's most popular industrial tour is **The Boeing Airplane Assembly Plant**. Thousands of visitors from nearly every nation have visited this landmark. The 747/767 Assembly Plant features the world's largest building on its 773-acre site. The actual building is 11 stories tall and all

under one roof. The Assembly Plant can accommodate 16 planes in final assembly at one time! The weekday tours are very popular.

From Everett, travel east on Hwy 2 to Leavenworth ...

The last leg of the trip offers charming, rustic surroundings and incredible scenery. In **Goldbar**, there is the **Skykomish Fish Hatchery**, where millions of salmon are hatched every year. **Wallace Falls State Park** has a hiking trail leading up to the falls, where you will find great views of the area. **Stevens Pass** is a popular ski area for snowboarders and both downhill and cross-country skiers. **Steelhead fishing** is excellent in the winter months, and snowmobiling and snowshoeing can also be enjoyed here. The longest railroad tunnel in North America is seven miles long and travels 1000 feet under Stevens Pass.

Stay on Hwy 2 and follow the signs to Leavenworth ...

Leavenworth is home to **Nussknacker Haus**, the world's largest nutcracker museum. Hundreds of nutcrackers of all sizes and colors are available for purchase. The neighboring town of **Cashmere** is home to the nationally-acclaimed **Aplets**

and Cotlets Factory. For more than 70 years, this family-owned confectionery has been filling the cupboards and stomachs of many Americans. A tour takes you through the production process from start to finish and gives you a free taste of the delicious candy.

From Seattle, WA

Before heading for your getaway in the mountains, be sure to explore **Seattle**. Whether watching the **Washington State Ferries**, dining on fresh seafood, shopping at famous **Pike Place Market**, touring the award-winning **Seattle Aquarium**, or just enjoying the liveliness of downtown and the culture of the **International District**, you'll enjoy your time in the Emerald City.

Drive east on I-90 to Exit 80 ...

The historic town of **Roslyn**, where the hit television show "Northern Exposure" was filmed, offers several eateries. Four miles east of Roslyn is the town of **Cle Elum**, with both shopping and dining.

Continue east, following signs to Highway 970, which joins Highway 97. Drive north on Highway 97 to Highway 2 and turn left (west). From this point, it is five miles to Leavenworth.

Driving Directions

From the north

- Drive I-5 S toward Everett.
- **Just north of Everett, take US-2 E through Monroe, Sultan, and over Stevens Pass to Leavenworth (approx. two hours).**
- **In Leavenworth, drive along Hwy-2 to Third St, turn right.**
- **Continue one short block to a stop sign.**
- **Turn right onto Commercial and proceed to where the road forks.**
- **Take the left fork, Scholze St.**
- **At Enchantment Park Way, turn left, travel 1/4 block to the Park Village Resort, which will be on your immediate right.**

From the south (via I-90)

- Take I-5 N to Seattle, then I-90 E to exit 85.
- Follow signs to Hwy-970, which joins Hwy-97.
- Drive north on Hwy-97 to Hwy 2 and turn left (west).
- From this point, it is 5-miles to Leavenworth.
- *Drive through Leavenworth to Third St and turn left.*
- Follow the **bold underlined** directions above.

From the south (via US 2)

- Drive I-5 N to Everett. Follow the **bold directions above.**



From the east

- Take I-90 W to WA-281 N exit-Exit 151 toward Quincy/Wenatchee.
- Turn right onto WA-281A and right onto WA-281/WA-281 N.
- Turn left onto F St SW/WA 28. Continue on WA-28 W.
- Turn left onto US 2 West/US 97 S., merge onto US 2 W toward Ellensburg/Seattle and follow the *italicized* directions to the left.
