Things to See and Do in St. George

Southern Utah is a transcendent network of salmon-hued rock, interconnected canyonland, gnarled tree trunks and mysterious hoodoos. WorldMark St. George gives you perfect access to Utah's Color Country. Be forewarned, however: you'll need to pace yourself. There are so many things to do in the St. George area.

Surrounded by barren desert, the green of St. George is an almost surprising sight. With numerous courses of cool, manicured grass, the town is a year-round golf community with links known for challenging layouts, striking scenery and impeccable maintenance. Situated above the Santa Clara River, Sunbrook tempts golfers with 27 holes among hollows, lakes and waterfalls. Another contender for Utah's best is 18-hole, par-71 Green Spring, overlooking red cliffs and Pine Valley Mountain.

But there's more to this town than golf. Other St. George standouts include history and antique buildings. The city is home to the first temple, the St. George Temple, built after the Mormons' exodus to Utah. Completed in 1877, the temple is flat-out impressive. For that matter, so is the St. George Tabernacle (completed in 1876),

with its 140-foot clock tower. St. George is also the site of Brigham Young's winter home, an 1873 two-story adobe house in the heart of town.

Of course, a big plus for St. George is its location "in the middle of it all," just as the visitors' bureau slogan claims. The city is only a two-hour drive from Las Vegas (with fun all its own), and two hours in a different direction from Bryce Canyon National Park. Visit here and you can hike Queen's Garden and Navajo Loop and wander through the hoodoos—the eroded, fantastically shaped rock formations that fill the canyon.

Only 42 miles from St. George is Zion National Park. A verdant valley lined by massive red monoliths, Zion is a photogenic desert oasis. Hikes here, such as the Hidden Canyon trail, offer sandstone-brick switchbacks, stone stairways and narrow ledges far above the Virgin River and canyon floor.

Gunlock Reservoir, situated among small hills and moderate vegetation, is home to a host of bass and crappie, and its southern shore offers a boat ramp and a primitive campground. Just 10 miles north of St. George lies Snow Canyon State Park, with its small collection of red sandstone cliffs,

twisted rock layers and lava flows. It boasts a lovely scenic drive and more short hiking trails.

Cedar City, 50 miles north of St. George, serves as a perfect base for exploring the plateau and, come late summer, this small town hosts possibly the nation's best Shakespearean Festival. Recreational activities of a different sort are available at the casinos in Mesquite, Nevada, only 30 miles southwest.

The St. George area has it all—desert climate, world-renowned nature, historic architecture, award-winning theater, golf perfection and even plenty of shopping. Make time to take advantage of all there is to do here.

Driving Directions

From Las Vegas, NV

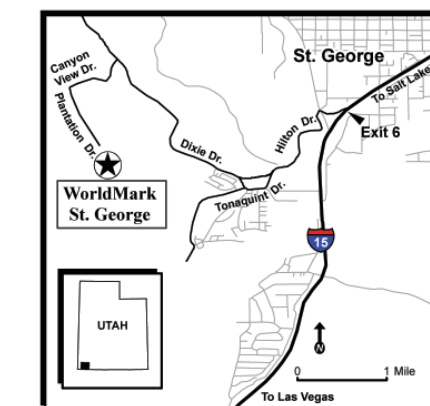
- Drive north on I-15 across the Arizona and Utah borders; take Exit 6 (Bluff St).
- Turn left onto Bluff St.
- Turn left at the second traffic signal onto Hilton.
- Turn immediately left again, to stay on Hilton.
- Hilton becomes Dixie Dr.
- Travel 3.1 miles and turn left onto Canyon View Dr. (Look for the Olive Grove housing development on the right).
- Continue 3/4 mile ahead to Plantation Dr. (sign will say "Private" as well) and turn left.
- Turn left on the first private drive.

From Phoenix, AZ

- Follow Hwy 60 North to Wickenburg.
- Take Hwy 93 to Las Vegas.
- Follow the directions from Las Vegas to the left.

From Salt Lake City, UT

- Drive South on I-15.
- From I-15, take Exit 6 (Bluff St).
- Turn right onto Bluff.
- Take first left onto Hilton Dr.
- **Make another immediate left to stay on Hilton.**
- **Hilton becomes Dixie Dr.**
- **Travel 2 miles and turn left on Canyon View Dr. (Look for the Olive Grove housing development on the right).**



- Continue 3/4 mile ahead to Plantation Dr. (sign will say "Private" as well) and turn left.
- Turn left on the first private drive.
